BODY PROTECTORS

Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" 2018 (Blue) shown on the label. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. Air jackets may be worn. If a member chooses to wear an air jacket, they are allowed in addition to a normal body protector which meets BETA 2018 level 3 standard. Air jackets must not be worn under any jacket or body protector and numbers must be fitted with elasticated fastenings. When an air jacket inflates the sudden noise can startle horses, thereby causing difficulties for other members in confined areas e.g. Indoor schools and menages. Therefore, air jackets are not encouraged to be used in those areas except for medical reasons. Whilst not compulsory at this show in Horse Worker classes, we do recommend they are worn.

HATS

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats no: PAS 015 2011, VG1(BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 & E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards, MUST always be worn by riders when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet Covers are encouraged. Hat TAGGING in BSPS classes is encouraged – we will tag hats at this show if needed (British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags are accepted). **PLEASE NOTE THAT IN ALL RIDDEN CLASSES GREAT ECCLESTON AGRICULTURAL SHOW RULES APPLY AND CORRECTLY SECURED HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.**

GREAT ECCLESTON AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY EQUINE INFLUENZA POLICY

It is strongly recommended that all horses/ponies entered must have been vaccinated to comply with the following requirements. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows from 1 Jan 2024, the first two vaccinations 21-60 days apart, a third booster between 150-180 days and an annual vaccination booster within 365 days thereafter. No pony/horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination.

NCPA

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show the Year 2025. 1st, & 2nd prize winners in the appropriate classes will qualify. Cards will be handed out in the ring. Visit www.thencpa.co.uk for membership & more information about how to enter.

CHAPS UK AFF NO: 25-040

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) affiliation number 40. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be current showing member and present their valid qualifier Card. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship show will be held in August 2025. Classes 51-55 are CHAPS (UK) qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members handbook or www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Skewbald's & Piebald's may compete in these classes. All Stallions 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS UK to compete and must wear Stallion CHAPS ID discs in the ring without exception. This show is a qualifier for the Carol Cooper King of The Ring Final .

BSPS RULES AFF. NO: 811/25

This show is affiliated to the BSPS, and all classes are held in accordance with the 2025 Rule & Show Handbook and all persons entering, competing, showing, or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Please take note of Rule 63 (1)a regarding DOPE Testing in the 2025 BSPS Rule book

This show is a qualifier for the 2025 BSPS Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge.

Classes are run under the rules in the current BSPS rule book – www.bsps.com for further information. Please note that grooms must have attained their 12th birthday for stripping in the ring, or for lunging on the show field except for stallions where the age limit is in accordance with rules 298 & 299 in the current BSPS rule book. Please also note the age of riders or Stallions in BSPS Heritage Ridden classes are in accordance with rules 298 & 299 of the current BSPS rule book.

THE BSPS THOR ATKINSON STEEL LTD CHALLENGE 2025

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Thor Atkinson Steel Ltd Challenge. Animals must have qualified for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competed in the appropriate class. Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, SHP, Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WHP, Int. SRT, SH & WH & Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the HOYS 2025. If a pony qualifies for the HOYS 2025 it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st prize-winners in the following classes will qualify for the Binks Family Champion of Champions; - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st Prize Winners in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify for The Binks Family Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

BSPS LONDON INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifier for the London International Horse Show BSPS Qualifying Classes. Only one pony in each of the following classes 20,21,22,27,28, 30, 31, 57 & 58 will qualify and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in each class will qualify. Non-members of the BSPS have 7 days to complete their registration and membership to keep the qualification. If not, this will be passed to the next exhibitor. The BSPS Performance Coloured classes are open to mares or Geldings & CHAPS (UK) or BSPA graded stallions, 4 yrs. old and over to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of the main body of the stud book of CHAPS(UK) or the BSPA. Ponies can be registered with either of these Societies or the BSPS and owner and riders must be or become members of the BSPS within 7 days to take the qualification.

BSHA RISING STARS LONDON INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHW QUALIFERS AFF NO: 25-038

This show is a qualifier for the London International Horse Show BSHA Rising Stars Supreme Final. The following classes are qualifiers 47,48 & 75 & 76. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify. A results points table will run for qualifying classes and a 'Wild card' will be awarded to those unqualified with the highest points in each section following the final qualifier. The judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes or at the Finals. Open to members and pre-registered non-members, 15 yrs. & over eligible under the Rising Star Amateur rules. Please note: Rising Star Amateur Rules 2025 are separate to BSHA Amateur rules. Please see the full list of Rising Star rules in the Rising Star section available on the BSHA web site www.britishshowhorse.org. If in any doubt about your Rising Star status, please contact the BSHA Office directly to have your status confirmed. In addition, the two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the appropriate Associate Rising Star final at the BSHA National Championship show in September. Qualification cards will be handed out in the ring.

TGCA TOYS INHAND & RIDDEN CLASSES AFFILIATION NUMBER

No known breeding required to enter these classes. No membership is required to enter these classes. TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TCGA) National Breed Championship Show 'TOYS'. Traditional classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Traditional Finals at TOYS. Part Bred classes are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at TOYS. The exhibit must have one parent that is a traditional gypsy cob. Stallions (4yrs & over) in order to enter and TCGA affiliated class MUST be TCGA registered, have passed their TCGA stallion evaluations and their TCGA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of 2 MUST be shown in a Stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the TCGA current rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non- members must receive a qualification card from the judge in the ring and have 21 days to join TGCA and to register their horse to validate the qualification. THE SHOWING REGISTER AMATEUR OF THE YEAR QUALIFIERS

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
2. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. In order to enter a Stallion class at an affiliated show.
3. ENTIRE Males aged 4 years old and over must have an 'S' number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPSBS voluntary veterinary examination. Ridden stallions must display a stallion bridle badge. In hand entire males 2 yrs. old and over are advised to display a stallion badge.
4. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs. old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs. old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs. or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 yrs. old and over.
4. This show is affiliated to GEMS (Group established for Miniature Shetlands) – The Highest placed GEMS member wearing a GEMS badge in classes 99,100,101,102,103,104 will receive a GEMS rosette.
