The Goat Classes are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the British Goat Society as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name, number and identification mark being quoted on the entry form plus the kidding date for goats in milk. No entries will be accepted unless CAE blood test results are on BGS submission forms or Premium Sheep and Goat Health Scheme forms. This is to enable quick and accurate confirmation of the status of the goats attending a show. Entries for all kids must be accompanied by the necessary valid certificate for their dams. If any herds have had a positive CAE result, they must provide two clear whole herd tests, completed since the reactor has been culled. The tests must not be more than 12 months apart and not less than 6 months apart. All goats in milk must be on the showground not later than 5.30pm on Friday 17 July 2026 and will be stripped out under the supervision of stewards at 6.00pm. Full udder inspection 6.30am on Saturday 18 July 2026. All other goats must be on the showground not later than 9.30am on Saturday 18 July 2026. Judging will commence at 10.00am. **All stock to remain on the showground until 5.00pm.** Exhibitors travelling from other shows must inform the chief steward prior to the day of the show and arrive with a stripping certificate signed and dated by the chief steward of the show they are travelling from.

No entries will be accepted unless CAE blood test results are on BGS submission forms or Premium Sheep and Goat Health Scheme forms. This is to enable quick and accurate confirmation of the status of the goats attending a show. Entries for all kids must be accompanied by the necessary valid certificate for their dams. If any herds have had a positive CAE result, they must provide two clear whole herd tests, completed since the reactor has been culled. The tests must not be more than 12 months apart and not less than 6 months apart. All goats in milk must be on the showground not later than 5.30pm on Friday 17 July 2026 and will be stripped out under the supervision of stewards at 6.00pm. Full udder inspection 6.30am on Saturday 18 July 2026. All other goats must be on the showground not later than 9.30am on Saturday 18 July 2026. Judging will commence at 10.00am. **All stock to remain on the showground until 5.00pm.** Exhibitors travelling from other shows must inform the chief steward prior to the day of the show and arrive with a stripping certificate signed and dated by the chief steward of the show they are travelling from.
